Victims of cyber attacks

Citigroup

In 2011, over 200,000 customer information from contact details to account numbers were compromised, which resulted in \$2.7 million loss for the company.

K Box

In 2014, the personal data of 317,000 customers of karaoke bar chain K Box was exposed on the Internet owing to lax security measures.

2017 global ransomware attack

The cyber attack on 12 May 2017 has hit 200,000 victims in at least 150 countries, including several retail malls in Singapore.
